


Launch out into the deep,

## What is the N.E.T.S. Ministry?



Throughout the world, approximately 1.6 billion people have never heard the Good News of Jesus Christ. The task of world evangelism is so great, and can never be completed by foreign missionaries alone. Due to cultural and language barriers, national ministers can often reach into remote cities and villages outsiders could never touch. However, many anointed men and women of God often lack necessary support (in prayer, spiritual encouragement, equipment, and finances) to make their outreaches as effective as possible. 
